CALL TO ORDER

NEW BUSINESS

SANITATION RATE INCREASE - The proposed sanitation rate increase was discussed, along with a breakdown of the current and proposed rates. The current monthly rate is \$16.23, and the proposed rate is \$18.61, representing an increase of \$2.38 per month. The Clerk-Treasurer will review whether any additional processing fees are included in the current rate and will contact Zach Klutz for legal guidance regarding the process.

DLZ - Casey Erwin provided updates on all ongoing projects but no action items were presented for consideration at this time.

A&K - POLE BARN RENOVATION

Renovation of the maintenance pole barn was discussed. Council questioned whether funds had been budgeted for the proposed improvements. The Clerk-Treasurer will touch base with Bakertilly regarding the budget.

SCHEDULE CHANGES - Council agreed to amend two dates on the 2026 Council meeting schedule.

CLERK TREASURER - Financial Report

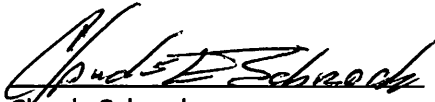

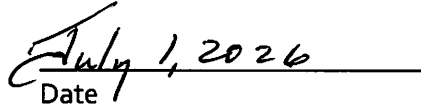
